Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Vice President Ann Jordan at 1:10 pm. There were 18 members present.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited by the group.

Reports

Secretary Minutes: The minutes of the May membership meeting were presented.

The secretary corrected the amount Linda Brick received in April of \$67.00 was for refreshment expenses for **Book Bingo**, and book sale expenses. Motion to accept the minutes as was made by Erin Layton, seconded by Linda Brick. Motion carried.

Treasurer-Financial Report: Lisa Sutton presented the financial report. There is \$8,720.96 in the Prime Share account, and \$595.89 in the checking account for a total of \$9,316.85. Deb Rosczyk made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report, seconded by Mary Lou Jennette. Motion carried.

Lisa Sutton stated that we have budgeted to pay the library up to \$1700.00 toward the summer program. Colleen does not have all the expenses yet, but she doesn't feel that it will go over that amount. Lisa asked for a motion to allow her to pay the bill when received. Sue Glover made the motion; Kathy Lawrence seconded it.

It was also suggested that the Friends have a coffee pot at the library, so that people who bring in snacks do not have to bring a coffee pot from home. Would anyone in the group have one that is not being used and would like to donate. Linda Brick feels we could use two pots, one for regular, one for decaf. If not, possibly we can purchase them.

Membership: We have 99 paid members. 16 Lifetime members.
